EDITORIAL

The year 2024 has consolidated EuropaNova's strategic role as a think tank for civil society, bringing together citizens and European leaders, particularly in a context of significant transition marked by the change of European mandate and the renewal of the European Parliament.

To this end, EuropaNova's main activity focused on the production and sharing of the **Conclave 2023 report**, which was the starting point for a structuring reflection on 17 European issues. Following the Conclave, EuropaNova identified four major European strategic axes for the 2040 horizon:

- **Co-constructing new European public goods**
- **Co-building scientific and technological power**
- **Co-constructing an inclusive and equitable development model**
- **Co-constructing democratic power**

In order to concretize the discussions resulting from the Conclave, EuropaNova orchestrated the **Symposium 2024**, in collaboration with Polytechnique. Bringing together many members of the European scientific community, this event constituted a strategic call for reindustrialization, highlighting three critical axes: the creation of a single market for research, the development of ambitious support policies and the engagement of youth as a vector of innovation.

2024 was also a year marked by the European elections, which motivated EuropaNova to commit to analysing and contributing to the public debate on European political priorities, in a context where concerns have evolved. While the 2019 elections focused on climate change, those of 2024 put more emphasis on economic issues, including citizens' purchasing power. In this context, **EuropaNova asked the European candidates about their priorities, offering a comparative analysis with the 2019 political offer**. This initiative aims to raise awareness of European issues, disseminate the candidates' ideas, and strengthen the dialogue between leaders and citizens, thus contributing to a more informed and participatory European consciousness.

The ambition for 2024 is clear: to reinvent the European project by placing innovation, inclusion and democracy at the heart of European transformation.

EuropaNova has demonstrated over the year that the future of Europe depends on a collective capacity to think together, to develop new models of cooperation and to constantly reinvent itself. Indeed, in a tense geopolitical context, marked at the end of the year by increased priorities on defence and security, the lessons of the conclave and the reflections carried out throughout 2024 inspired the preparation of the next Conclave planned for 2025.

Presentation of the results of the Conclave at the Romanian Embassy - February 1, 2024



As part of the publication of the first report of the Conclave held in November 2023 in Cascais, Portugal, EuropaNova presented its results on 1 February 2024 at the Romanian Embassy in Paris. The publication of the Conclave's conclusions was also the occasion chosen to celebrate the anniversary of EuropaNova, founded 20 years ago.

Also present, Guillaume Klossa, President of EuropaNova, and Isabelle Négrier, General Manager, hosted the meeting with more than 150 guests alongside the Romanian Ambassador Ioana Bivolaru.

The publication of the Conclave conclusions was also the occasion chosen to celebrate the anniversary of EuropaNova, founded 20 years ago. Many French and European personalities and decision-makers present at this event, including Pascal Canfin and Valérie Drezet-Humez, were able to discover the strong priorities for the future of Europe.

3 Club EuropaNova x Politico Européenne 2024

Five years after the last European elections in 2019, it was time to elect our representatives to the European Parliament in 2024. This is why EuropaNova, in partnership with Politico, organised 3 public debates where the three main candidates for the European elections, Valérie Hayer (March 28), Jordan Bardella (April 3) and Raphaël Glucksmann (April 17), were able to express themselves.

During these events, guests were able to debate questions posed by the public as well as by Politico journalists.

This very fruitful exchange allowed us to reflect on issues dear to Europeans, fundamental for the future of the Union. In the interests of democratic fairness, EuropaNova also decided to give the floor to all the main candidates in the elections during interviews with Isabelle Négrier.

Around fifteen filmed interviews were posted on EuropaNova's social networks and generated positive reactions and feedback from its audience.

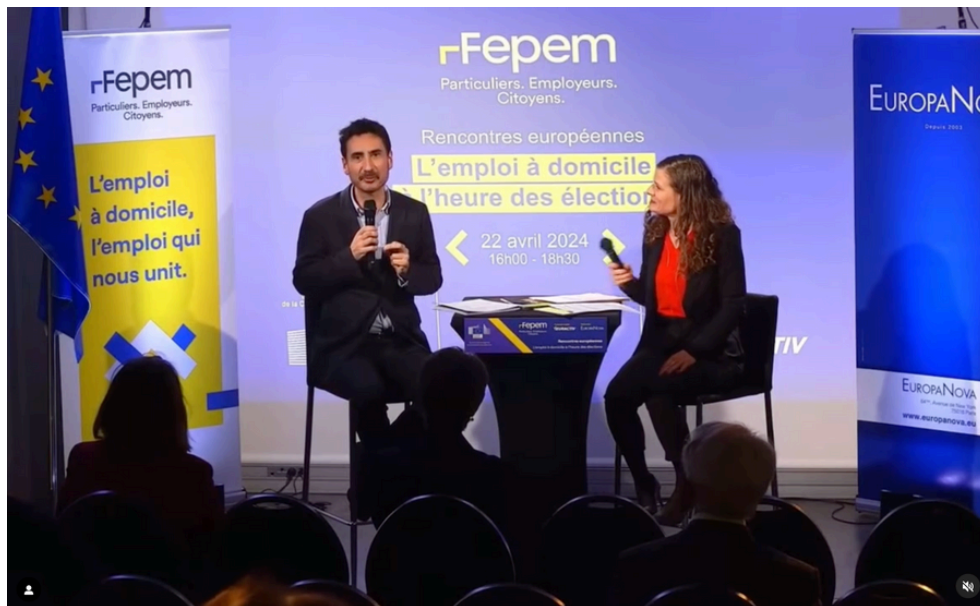

Symposium 2024 - Debate on innovation with Polytechnique - June 17, 2024



The Symposium brought together leading experts in research, industry and technology on 17 June 2024 to discuss European innovation priorities. Organised by EuropaNova in partnership with the Institut Polytechnique de Paris and JEDI, the event highlighted the urgent need for increased R&D funding to strengthen Europe's technological sovereignty and boost its global competitiveness.

Speakers included Jean-Pierre Vidal, Economic Advisor to European Council President Charles Michel, and other influential figures such as Jean Tirole and Antoine Petit. More than 2,000 participants attended keynotes and round tables on the challenges of research, technological innovation and the infrastructure needed to build a stronger and more independent Europe.

This symposium presented the conclusions of the 2023 European Conclave, focused on technological sovereignty, and compiled the perspectives of many experts in the EuropaNova Proceedings. These recommendations aim to alert European decision-makers to the importance of investing massively in research and innovation, an essential condition for reindustrializing Europe and securing its economic future.

The discussions highlighted the need for a single market for research, ambitious support policies and increased engagement with youth to make Europe a global technology leader.

Women4Cyber Conference - November 25, 2024



On November 25, 2024, EuropaNova organized the Women4Cyber France forum, in partnership with the Women4Cyber Foundation and ECSO, to highlight the underrepresentation of women in the field of cybersecurity, which has only 22% of women in Europe and 17% in France.

Inaugurated by Isabelle Negrier, the event brought together professionals, mentors and young talents (mentees) to encourage networking and support female careers in this booming sector, with growth of +30% in Europe.

Discussions focused on current challenges, technological trends such as AI and automation, as well as opportunities to strengthen diversity and innovation in this strategic area. The event also highlighted the importance of international and European collaboration to effectively combat cyber threats, highlighting the key role of public-private partnerships and European cooperation. Key companies in the field such as Airbus reaffirmed their commitment to diversity in cybersecurity, illustrating that inclusion is a lever for innovation and sustainable security.

This forum thus served as a springboard to promote greater diversity in cybersecurity, demonstrating that the joint contribution of women and men is essential to shaping a more inclusive and secure future.

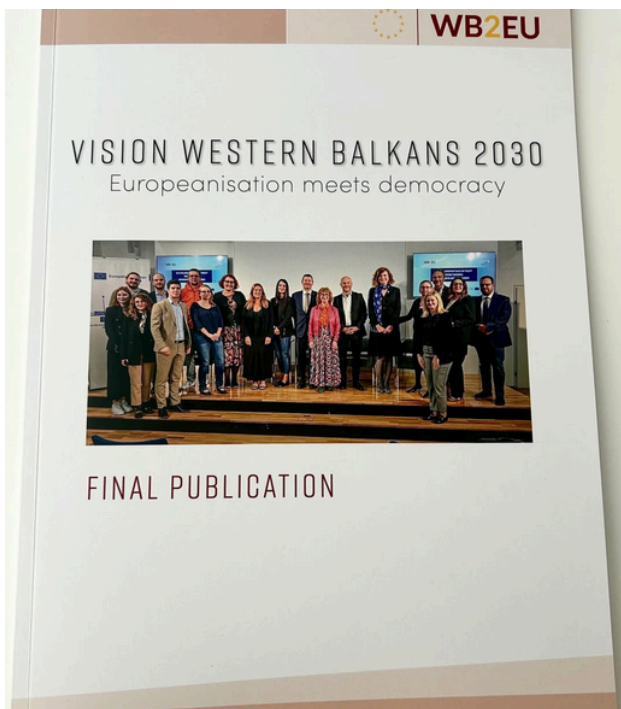

Final publication of the Western Balkans to the European Union (WB2EU) project

February 2024



The Western Balkans to the European Union (WB2EU) project came to an end earlier this year, concluding nearly 4 years of research. The project was driven by the issue of EU enlargement to the Balkan countries and the French refusal to open negotiations with North Macedonia and Albania.

The political situation remains complicated in the region, which is gripped by elite clientelism and corruption.

Nevertheless, EuropaNova's goal was to mobilize support by bringing together researchers, academics, civil society representatives and other European citizens engaged on the issue. The results of this project were published on February 6 in a report entitled Vision Western Balkans 2030: Europeanisation meets democracy. The topics addressed by the report generate engagement among European citizens, such as the rule of law, democracy, freedom and social justice. EuropaNova actively worked towards the publication of the latter, ultimately allowing the writing of an article by Marc Nebojsa Vukadinovic, member of our scientific committee, "The French perspective on EU Enlargement and vision towards the Western Balkans".

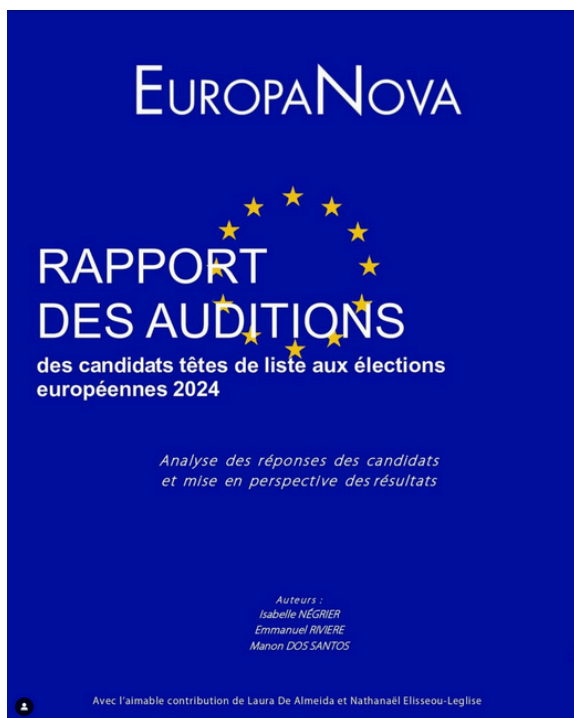
Following the presentation of the first conclusions of the Conclave in early February at the Romanian Embassy in Paris, the final report “Europe 2040: Tomorrow is being played out today. Co-building a global, sustainable and responsible power. 17 fundamental questions” was published on 21 March 2024 under the direction of the Conclave Board. This report sets out the 17 priorities for Europe that the 50 guests of the Conclave determined during these three days last November. Organised into 4 main axes, European geopolitical power, scientific and technological power, fair and inclusive development and European democratic power, these results offer a vision of Europe by 2040. “Tomorrow is today” says Guillaume Klossa, Chairman of the Conclave Board.

Report of the hearings of the lead candidates for the 2024 European elections. Analysis and responses from the candidates and putting the results into perspective

June 2024



Among the 38 lists submitted to the prefecture, EuropaNova met no fewer than 24 list leaders, representing a representative sample of the French political spectrum. The interviews conducted by Isabelle Négrier allowed EuropaNova to ask the same 6 questions to all candidates and ultimately, the writing of this report.

Written with the help of Emmanuel Rivière, member of the EuropaNova scientific committee, the report offers an analysis of the candidates' discourse in the face of the expectations of European citizens, using tools such as Eurobarometers. The report was published ahead of the European elections in France in order to provide voters with the 2024 political trends that are emerging with regard to Europe, 5 years after the 2019 elections.

On the occasion of the European elections which took place from June 6 to 9, EuropaNova decided to give the floor to all the leading candidates in a democratic approach.

Les Actes published on June 26, 2024 compile the views of nearly twenty European panelists, from both academia and industry. Nearly twenty renowned panelists from academia and industry, this major event provided an in-depth exploration of the contemporary challenges of research and technological development.

Keynote presentations by experts such as Agnieszka Wykowska and Jean Tirole highlighted the imperatives of investment and competitiveness, underlining the urgent need for Europe to strengthen its research and innovation capacities. With over 2,000 participants connected on-site and remotely, the symposium offered a platform for rich and strategic dialogue, putting into perspective the critical issues of research funding, technological transformation and the engagement of young talents in building a more innovative and resilient European future.

EuropaNova Report on the 2024 European Elections

July 2024



EuropaNova's report on the June 2024 European elections, led by Isabelle Négrier, offers an in-depth analysis of the political dynamics that marked this crucial vote.

Analyzing in detail the comparative results since 2019, the document highlights a significant trend towards the rightward shift of the European Parliament, characterized by a rise of the extreme right and a decrease in seats for the Renew Europe and Greens groups.

In a context of major institutional renewal, symbolised in particular by Antonio Costa's future presidency of the European Council from 1 December 2024, this report deciphers electoral changes across the 27 Member States. By closely examining turnout rates, voting methods and national political trends, EuropaNova offers a strategic reading that helps understand the political reconfigurations that are set to shape the European agenda for the period 2024-2029, thus providing valuable analytical insight into the democratic evolution of the continent.

In the context of the 2024 European elections, EuropaNova publishes an in-depth and critical analysis on the harmonization of European law on July 12, 2024.

This publication highlights an electoral event transformed into national polls, where the European dimension has been singularly hidden. The study offers a nuanced overview of the prospects for legal developments, focusing particularly on two strategic areas: business law and private law concerning child custody in the event of intra-European divorce.

Based on interviews conducted by EuropaNova's Director General with the leading candidates, this analysis offers a critical look at the commitment of current political parties to legislative harmonisation. It highlights the challenges and missed opportunities to build a more integrated and coherent legal framework within the European Union, while documenting existing progress and potential prospects for normative convergence.

Report on “Energy: positions of the leading candidates for the European elections”

July 2024



The report explores the positions of the leading candidates for the 2024 European elections regarding energy policy.

This shift is amplified by crises such as the invasion of Ukraine and inflation, which have brought energy sovereignty back to the forefront of debates. The report highlights the progress made by the European Union, notably through a common legislative framework, while recalling the need to continue efforts for sustainable energy integration.

The analysis of the platforms reveals a marked polarization between the candidates. Some, such as those on the far right, favor nuclear power while rejecting renewable energies, which they consider unreliable or harmful. Conversely, the radical left and environmentalists favor renewable energies and question the efficiency of nuclear power. The issue of the electricity market is also divisive, with proposals ranging from reform to complete exit. This report thus reflects the tensions between divergent visions of the energy transition in Europe, while emphasizing the need for a balanced approach to ensure independence and sustainability.

October 2024



In a rapidly changing geopolitical and technological context, the article by Oliver Costa, member of the EuropaNova scientific committee, offers an insightful strategic analysis of the challenges of European technological competitiveness.

This article, published on October 14, 2024, highlights the structural obstacles that hamper continental innovation, including an underdeveloped venture capital ecosystem, overly rigid labor regulations, and a culture of innovation that is less dynamic than that of its international competitors.

By documenting a significant technology investment gap - with European companies investing six times less in R&D than their American counterparts - the study does not just draw up an alarmist diagnosis, but offers a constructive perspective aimed at repositioning Europe as a major player in global innovation. Under the presidency of Guillaume Klossa, this academic work constitutes an essential contribution to the debate on European technological sovereignty, warning of the risks of marginalization and outlining the transformations necessary to guarantee the continent's competitiveness in the strategic sectors of tomorrow.

The EuropaNova scientific committee, chaired by Guillaume Klossa and presented by Olivier Costa, offers an in-depth analysis of the major geopolitical implications of the 2024 European elections and the potential return of Donald Trump in the United States.

This article highlights a complex European political landscape, marked by the rise of Eurosceptic and far-right parties, which is undermining continental cohesion despite the predominance of pro-European parties.

Faced with this unstable geopolitical context, characterized by the war in Ukraine, Chinese trade pressures and the rise of European skepticism, the study formulates three crucial strategic recommendations: a collective and united response to international challenges, increased investment in strategic areas such as defense, innovation and ecological transition, and a European integration reinforced by a reduction of unanimous decision-making processes. By highlighting the urgency of consolidating European unity and sovereignty, this academic work offers a forward-looking vision where integration appears as the only path to resilience and global competitiveness for the continent.

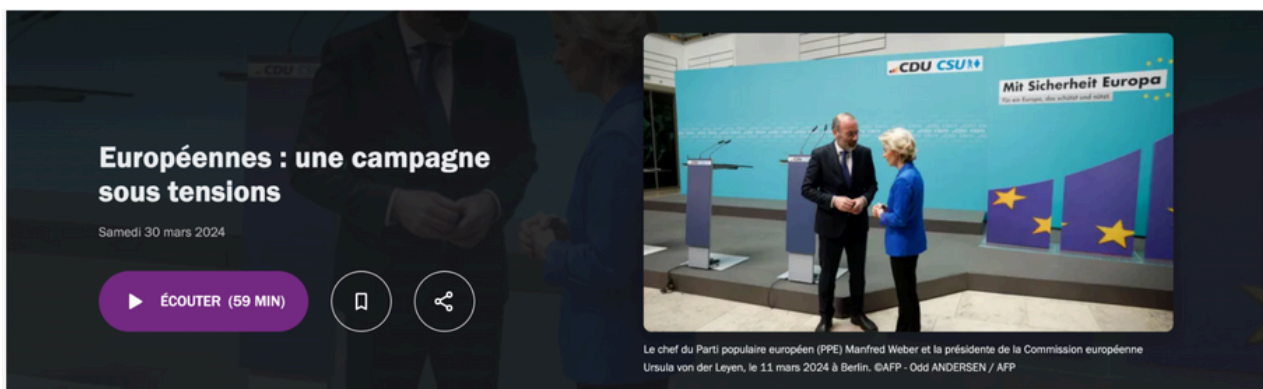

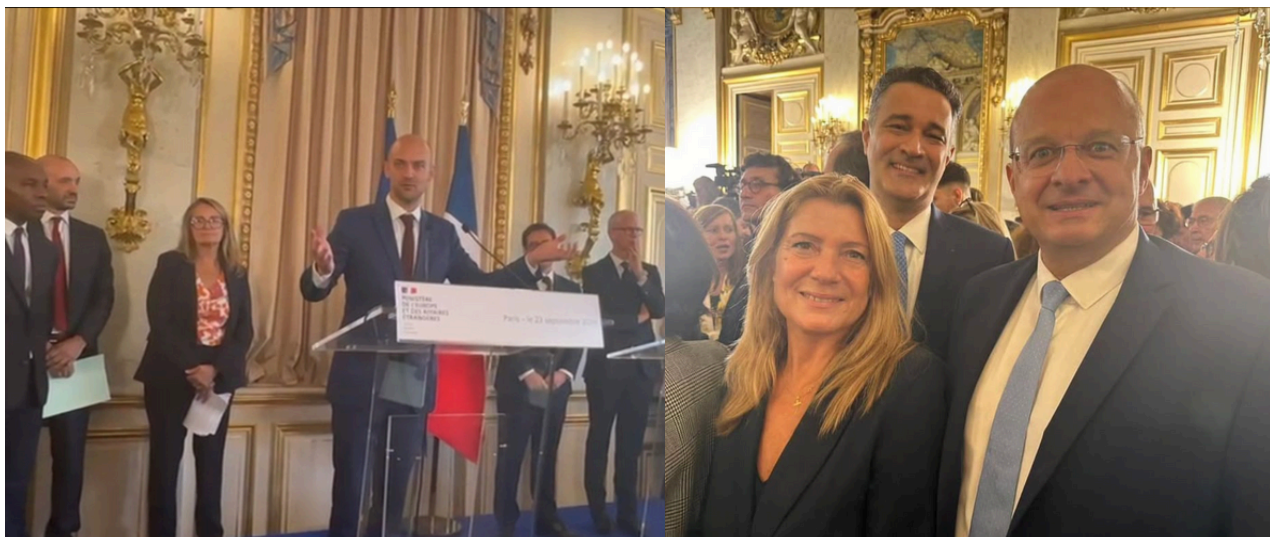

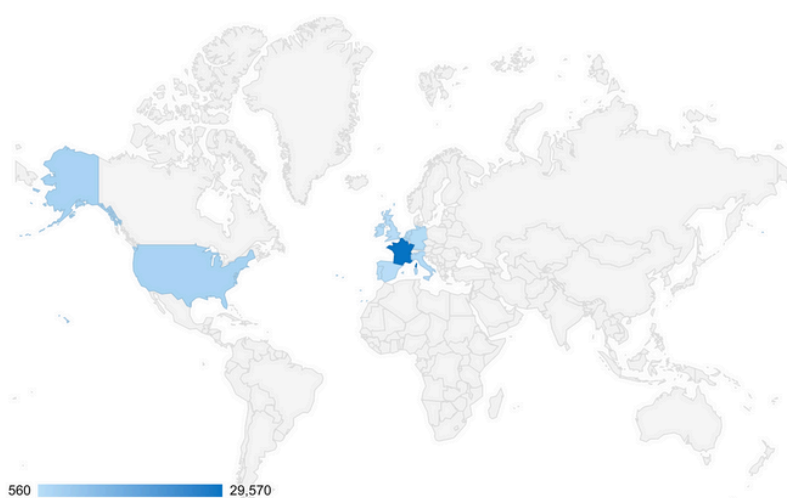
